## PREFACE

This volume constitutes the Proceedings of the 30th Semester held at the Stefan Banach International Mathematical Center for Raising Research Qualifications, Warsaw, from September 15 till December 17, 1987. Primary aim of the Banach Center is to create an opportunity for young mathematicians to attend lectures of invited specialists from all over the world. Naturally, this gives a chance that specialists meet, discuss their results and problems, and start (possibly joint) research work.

The international Scientific Council of the Banach Center fixed the theme "Combinatorics and Graph Theory" and appointed the following Professors to the Organizing Committee of the 30th Semester: Juraj Bosák, CS; Stefan Dodunekov, BG; Miroslav Fiedler, CS; László Lovász (vice-chairman), H; Oleg B. Lupanov (chairman), SU; Horst Sachs, DDR; Zdzisław Skupień, PL; Vera T. Sós, H; Ioan Tomescu, RO. The Organizing Committee fixed the following topics:

1. Algebraic and logical methods, the theory of discrete functions;
2. Enumeration, block designs, codes;
3. Structural and extremal problems of graph theory, polyhedral combinatorics;
4. Probabilistic methods, random graphs, Ramsey theory;
5. Combinatorial algorithms, complexity;
6. The theory of matroids and related systems, topological graph theory.

Altogether, 23 countries from three continents were represented by 183 registered participants, among them 97 invited speakers. Invited speakers stayed at the Center a few days, two weeks, or three weeks at the most, a number of remaining participants stayed longer. Altogether, 109 participants, among which 95 invited speakers, delivered more than 250 lectures of 45' each in general. Most of the papers in this volume were presented to the Semester.

We are very grateful to all authors and speakers, and to all participants for their cooperation. We thank the Director of the Banach Center, Professor Czesław Olech, as well as Mrs. Grażyna Pieścik, the secretary. We are very grateful to Dr. habil. Michał Karoński and Dr. Andrzej Ruciński for their organizational work during three weeks on topic 4 in November. We gratefully

acknowledge the help of some participants to organize informal afternoon meetings. Special thanks are due to all members of the Organizing Committee, including the late Professor J. Bosák.

All submitted papers have been refereed. The editors thank the following referees: H. Bielak, J. Florek, R. Kalinowski, M. Karoński, W. Kordecki, M. Kwaśnik, A. Marczyk, D. Michalak, K.
